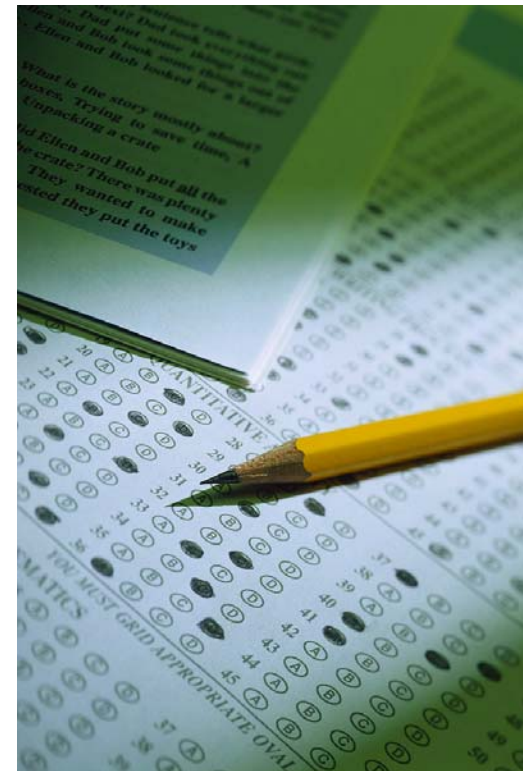

Grade 8 - New Jersey ASK8 on April 28, 29, 30, May 1
