

Bayonne School District Announces Policy Regarding Illegal Students

“The Bayonne Board of Education will continue its bounty program which will continue to provide additional sources of information to maximize the number of students determined to be illegally in the Bayonne School District,” states Dr. Patricia L. McGeehan, Superintendent of Schools. “Other school districts have undertaken a bounty system by offering a financial incentive for information leading to the successful removal of students illegally in a district. Therefore, at the October 22, 2009 public meeting, the Bayonne Board of Education passed a resolution to authorize the School Business Administrator to pay the sum of \$100.00 to any person (who is not an employee or relative of an employee of the Bayonne Board of Education) who will provide credible, factual information that leads to the removal of a student illegally in the Bayonne School District,” adds Superintendent McGeehan.
