

Bayonne Board of Education Receives Grant Award To Fund Safety & Security-Related Improvements

The New Jersey School Boards Association Insurance Group (NJSBAIG) awarded the Bayonne Board of Education a safety grant in the amount of \$70,075.04. This grant rewards the Board of Education for its commitment to risk management and will be used for the installation and maintenance of a basketball winch system and backstops in the high school, replacement of locker room floors and tiles at Lincoln School pool, replacement of floor tiles in ice rink lobby, and eight pedestrian cross-walk signs. In total, NJSBAIG awarded \$5 million in safety grants to member districts across the state.

The NJSBAIG, located in Burlington, New Jersey, is a non-profit entity which provides property, casualty, and workers' compensation insurance at competitive rates to New Jersey public schools. It is the only statewide, member-owned school district joint insurance fund.
