All students must earn a minimum of 125 total credits which include the following:

• English	4 years	20 credits
• Mathematics	3 years	15 credits
• Science	3 years	15 credits
• U.S. History	2 years	10 credits
• World History	1 year	5 credits
• P.E./Health	4 years	16-20 credits
• Fine Art	1 year	5 credits
• Practical Art	1 year	5 credits
• World Language	1 year	5 credits

In addition, all students must pass the HSPA and complete 20 hours of "Service Learning."

CURRICULUM

Bayonne High School is a 4 year comprehensive high school with strong academic and career preparation programs.

Honors courses are offered in English, Math, Social Studies, Science and World Language.

Through our partnership with NJIT, St. Peter's College, Seton Hall University and Rutgers University, students may earn College Credit for the following courses: Calculus, Probability and Statistics, Chemistry, Physics, Molecular Biology, French, Spanish, Italian, US History and Modern European History.

Students may also choose from a wide variety of career preparation programs including a business program rooted in a commitment to technology and an array of vocational courses including Carpentry, Welding, Building Trades, Culinary and TV Production.

Bayonne High School is comprised of four buildings on a thirteen acre campus set adjacent to the waterfront. The Bayonne High School Physical Education Center contains an NHL regulation ice rink, indoor track and dance studio. Four regulation tennis courts are adjacent to this building. The school also houses the district cable station (BEN TV) where students can take courses in TV production and a planetarium for astronomy courses. Bayonne High School has a state of the art security system for the safety and well-being of our students and staff.
