### **School Overview**

Bayonne High School has a strong academic program and an outstanding co-curricular program, encompassing athletics, drama, forensics, student government, music, fine arts, and several volunteer and service organizations.

Students may also choose from a wide variety of career preparation programs including a business program rooted in a commitment to technology and an array of vocational courses including carpentry, welding, building trades, automotive, culinary and TV production.

### **Graduation Requirements**

Bayonne High School students must successfully complete 125 credits to graduate as well as 20 hours of service learning. The requirements include:

20 credits English
15 credits Mathematics

15 credits Biology (5 cr), Chemistry (5 cr), Physics or Environmental (5 cr)

15 credits US History (10 cr), World History (5 cr)

10 credits Visual and Performing Arts (5 cr) and Career Education (5 cr)

5 credits World Language 5 credits per year of enrollment PE/Health

In addition, each student must earn minimum scores on the NJSLA assessments or alternative authorized assessment.

Advanced Placement courses (19) are identified as AP on the transcript and are offered in:

English: English Language and Composition, English Literature

Mathematics: Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Statistics, Computer Science A, Computer Science

Principles

Science: Biology, Chemistry, Physics 1, Physics 2

Social Studies: US History, US Government and Politics, Psychology, Macroeconomics,

Microeconomics, Human Geography, European History

Music: Music Theory

**Honors** courses (22) are identified as H on the transcript and are offered in:

English: English 9, 10, 11, 12

Mathematics: Algebra 1, Geometry, Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus

Science: Biology, Chemistry, Physics Social Studies: US History 1, 2, World History

World Language: Spanish 3, 4; Italian 3, 4; French, 3, 4; Latin 3, 4

AP Physics C, AP Chinese Language, AP Spanish Language, AP French Language, AP Studio Art Drawing and AP Studio Art 2D are no longer offered as of the 2019-2020 school year.

While teacher recommendations drive the course selection process, students can waive into Honors and AP courses, without restriction.

# **Grading and GPA Calculations**

A weighted grade point average (GPA) is calculated at the end of the sixth semester. A quality point value is assigned to each course. The total number of points earned is divided by the number of courses completed, and then the GPA is assigned. This weighted GPA is reported on the transcript.
