The required Advanced Placement exam is the culminating activity of the Advanced Placement course, students are <u>required</u> to sit for the exam.

Students who choose an Advanced Placement course must be highly motivated, willing to do outside reading, research, writing and be able to undertake supplemental work on their own initiative. **Some courses also require summer reading and/or writing assignments.** 

Since the culminating assessment for an AP course is the AP Examination, all students are required to sit for the examination in May. Failure to sit for the exam will result in the student being charged the testing fee and a test grade of a ZERO will be added to the student's class average.

Instructors will need to move very intensively through a tremendous amount of material to prepare students appropriately. Therefore, it is imperative that students attend class every day. If a student must be absent, it is the responsibility of the student to find out what work was missed and to complete the assignments in the designated time frame.

Since an AP course is considered a college-level class that may result in a student earning college credit, students must be certain they are ready to meet the challenges of a college curriculum. They must be organized and self-disciplined, with above average reading and writing skills. Learning is only successful when students are actively engaged in the process; therefore, what they achieve will depend on their personal commitment and involvement.

Parents/guardians should be aware that the rigor of an AP course(s) may impact the time and preparation a student must undertake at home.

To complete your registration for an AP course, the student and a parent/guardian must complete the attached contract. Contracts must be returned to your child's counselor immediately after their scheduling appointment, but no later than <a href="https://doi.org/10.1007/j.com/normalized-theory.com/normalize
