Thank you for applying to the **Bayonne High School and Hudson County Community College Early College Program**! Accuplacer testing will take place on <u>Saturday</u>, <u>March 12</u>, <u>2022</u> at Bayonne High School.

Students **must** bring the following with them to the test:

- A completed Accuplacer Admission Ticket
- CHARGED Chromebook
- Early College Program Student Agreement
- School ID (must be worn)
- Several #2 pencils with an eraser

## Students without the Admission Ticket or School ID will not be permitted to test.

- Students should enter through door #1 (main entrance on Avenue A).
- Check in is at 8:30 AM.
- Testing begins promptly at 9:00 AM. <u>Students who arrive late will not be permitted to test.</u>
- Cell phones, smart watches, or any other digital device, drinks or snacks, backpacks or pocketbooks are <u>not permitted</u> in the test site.
- Dismissal will be through door #1 at approximately 12:00 PM.
  - Students who are permitted to walk home, <u>must</u> have the *Authorization To Walk Home* section of your Admission Ticket signed by a parent/guardian.
  - If you are not permitted to walk home, your parents/guardian <u>must</u> be at Bayonne High School at 12:00 PM to pick you up.

## There will be no make up date for students who miss the test.

Please remember to eat a healthy breakfast and to get a good night sleep in order to perform your best on the assessment.
