Rules

- Each school's winning entry is to be sent to the Social Studies Office at Bayonne High School, 667 Avenue A by E.O.B., **May 3, 2017**.
- On a separate piece of paper, please include the following information: student's name, grade, name of school and teacher's name.

Judging:

- Entries will be judged on creativity, originality, clarity and composition, as well as how well the theme is conveyed.
- The winner will be announced on **May 17**.
- Prizes to be awarded.
- The winner and their family will be invited to a City Council Meeting.
