R 3244 InService Training CREDITS

The courses included in the Bayonne School District's In-Service Institute fulfill the requirements for approved in-service course work and may be used by professional staff towards salary increases within the district within the following quidelines:

- Increments as specified by the Collective Bargaining Agreement will be awarded for every 30 credits earned (these may include graduate school credits).
- One in-service credit will be earned for each five-week session (10 hours of course work).
- Staff members must maintain a minimum attendance rate of 80% in order to receive in-service credit.
- Staff members must successfully complete course requirements in order to receive in-service credit.
- In-service credit will not be given for repeating the same course. Courses must be sequential or significantly different if they deal with the same subject area.
- Every course participant will receive a "Certificate of Credit" as an official record of participation.
- Staff members who have previously participated in local in-service courses and earned in-service credits will have such credits included on an Equivalency Credit Form which will be placed in their personnel file.
