- 6. Professional development activities,
- 7. Condition of the school facilities,
- 8. Status of mandated program reviews,
- 9. Community support data; and

The Board will invite public discussion on issues related to the QAAR and members of the public will be heard in accordance with Policy No. 0167 on public participation in Board meetings.
