BAYONNE BOARD OF EDUCATION ELECTION

The election for members of the Bayonne Board of Education will be held on **Tuesday, November 3rd, 2020**. The deadline for filing to seek a seat on the nine (9) member board is **Monday, July 27th, 2020** at 4:00p.m.

Petitions are available on the county clerk's website at www.hudsoncountyclerk.org, if candidates wish to receive a hard copy of the petition; they must call the County Clerk Office for an appointment.

Completed nominating petitions must be submitted in person or electronically by either facsimile or email and must be received by 4:00 pm on **July 27, 2020**. Individuals submitting petitions in person must make an appointment by calling the Elections Division at 201-369-3470 Option #6.

The County Clerk – Elections Division is open between 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. and is located at 257 Cornelison Avenue - 4th Floor, Jersey City, NJ 07302. The contact number is 201-369-3470 extension 2767 or option 6.

There are **three (3)** seats available:

- Three (3) seats available each for a term of three (3) years which will be voted upon

Candidates filing a nominating petition for Board membership must meet the following qualifications:

- He/she is a citizen of the United States of America
- He/she must be at least eighteen (18) years of age to qualify for office
- He/she must be able to read and write
- He/she has been a resident of the municipality from which he/she is to be elected for at least one (1) year preceding the date of the election
- He/she is not disqualified as a voter pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:4-1
- He/she is a registered voter in the district
- Not hold office as a mayor or member of the governing body of the same district
- He/she is not disqualified from membership on the Board due to conviction of a crime or offense listed in N.J.S.A. 18A:12-1
- He/she has no interest in any contract with, or claim against, the Board
