HOMEWORK - ELEMENTARY SCHOOL

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The development and maintenance of sound homework procedures require the cooperative efforts of teachers, students, parents and administrators.

Since students have various levels of ability, homework activities will be assigned according to the particular needs of the class and of the individuals within the class. It is the responsibility of the student to:

1. Keep a written record of all homework assignments and complete them on time;
2. Obtain homework assignments, in the event of absence, and complete them in a reasonable length of time;
3. Discuss with the teacher any problem encountered while doing homework (term papers, book reports, etc.);

Homework will be incorporated in determining the marking period grade. A penalty for late assignments may be reflected in the grade assigned.

The amount of time required for homework each night (4-5 nights per week) will vary from individual, but the following should be considered as the approximate time limit for the average student.

1. provide a study area;
