R 2451 ADULT HIGH SCHOOL

A. Function

It is the function of the Bayonne Adult High School to provide for the education of its students through the provision of curricula in conformity with standards set by the New Jersey State Department of Education.

B. Philosophy

The school subscribes to the belief that the strength and well-being of the community and the nation is based upon the education of its citizens and that the aim of education is to help each individual discover and develop his or her emotional and intellectual capacities to their fullest extent.

C. Objectives

The objectives of the Adult High School shall be:

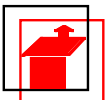
1. To provide a curriculum emphasizing basic skills and one designed to motivate all students and meet their needs.
2. To encourage logical thinking without bias or prejudice.
3. To instill respect for basic moral values, an appreciation of man's personal heritage, and a recognition of the dignity and worth of the individual.
4. To further social competency through cooperative action in the family and the community.

D. Implementation

In order to meet these objectives, the Director of Community Education shall annually publish a handbook of policies, regulations, and curricula for the Bayonne Adult High School subject to the approval of the Superintendent.

E. Course Credit

Students will work independently under the direction of certified staff members. The minimum requirement for
