

Message from the Superintendent February/March 2024

February is Black History Month. Each year there is a theme for the month, this year it is "African Americans and the Arts." We will be showcasing the impacts Black Americans have had on visual arts, music, cultural movements, and so much more. As they do every year, our Social Studies Department will be incorporating Black History month themes within their lessons and using pull out time to highlight key figures in American history both male and female. Additionally, the Social Studies Department will be incorporating recognition into their lessons for Presidents' Day which is Monday, February 19, 2024.

Also, February 29, 2024 is designated as "Rare Disease Day" which recognizes the importance of improving awareness and encouraging accurate and early diagnosis of rare diseases and disorders. A rare disease or disorder is one that affects a small number of patients, which, in the US, is considered to be a population of fewer than 200,000 persons.

This reading initiative is an annual reading motivation and awareness program that calls every child in every community to celebrate reading with the theme: Celebrating a Nation of Diverse Readers. Since 1987, the month of March has been designated as Women's History Month where we join in commemorating and encouraging the study, observance and celebration of the vital role of women in American History. The goal of NJ STEM Month is to celebrate New Jersey's commitment to student success in STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) programs. During the month, our Science, Technology, and Mathematics Departments will highlight efforts designed to increase access to STEM learning.
